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I. THE COMMISSION

The State of Rajasthan was formed as a result of the merger of the erstwhile, princely States situated in Rajputana and Part- 'C' State of Ajmer-Merwara. At the time of formation of Rajasthan the institution of Public Service Commission existed in only three of the twenty-two covenanting States, viz. Jaipur, Jodhpur and Bikaner.

The successor administration after the merger of the princely States promulgated on 16th August, 1949 an ordinance establishing, the Rajasthan Public Service Commission, but it came into existence from 22nd December, 1949 after issuing notification regarding appointment of Hon'ble Chairman and Members of the Commission.

The provisions regarding Public Service Commission for the Union and for the State and appointment & term of office of Members have been laid down in Article 315 & 316 respectively in the Constitution of India.

1.1 The functions of the Commission as laid down in Article 320 of the Constitution of India are given in Appendix-I.

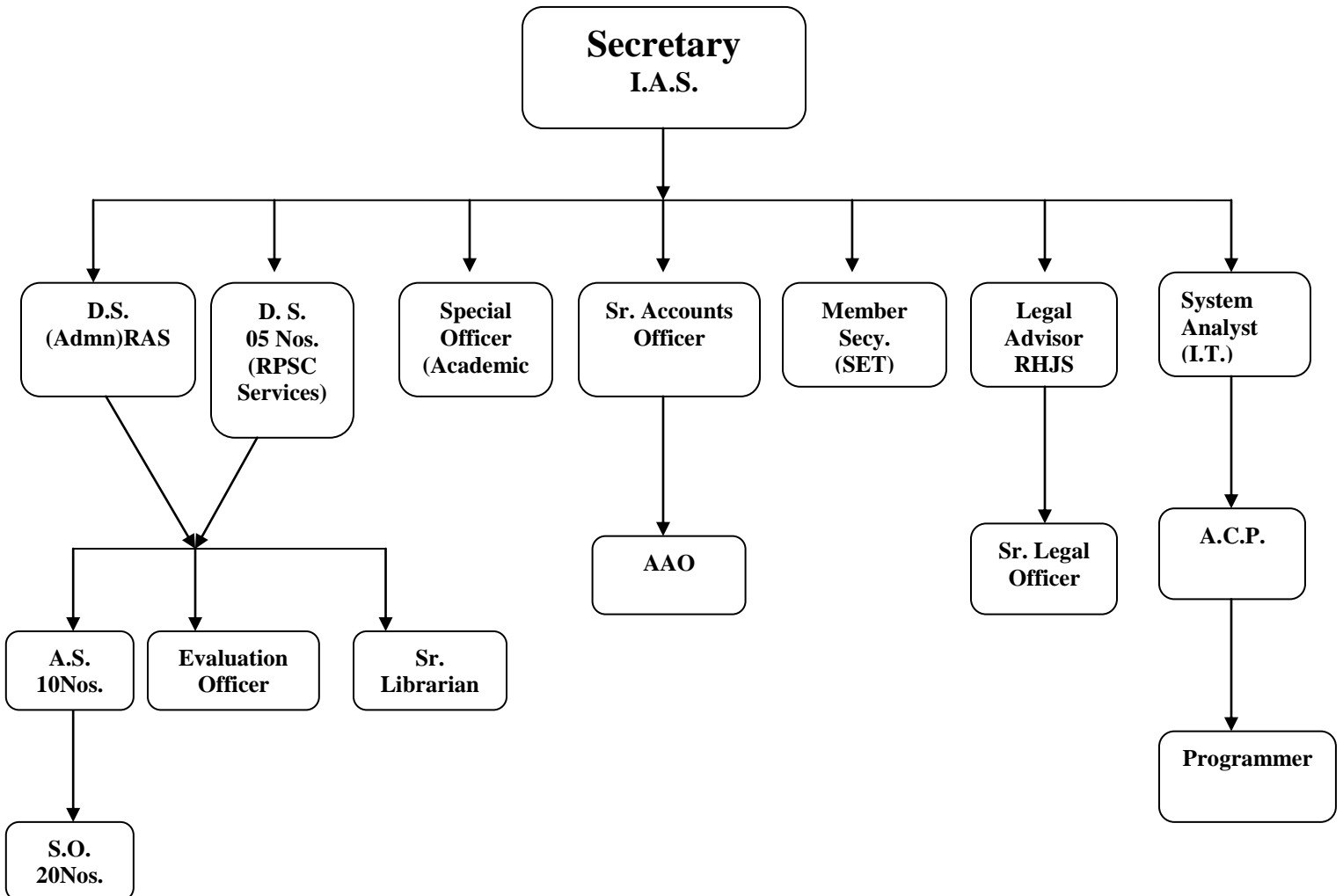

IV. RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURE

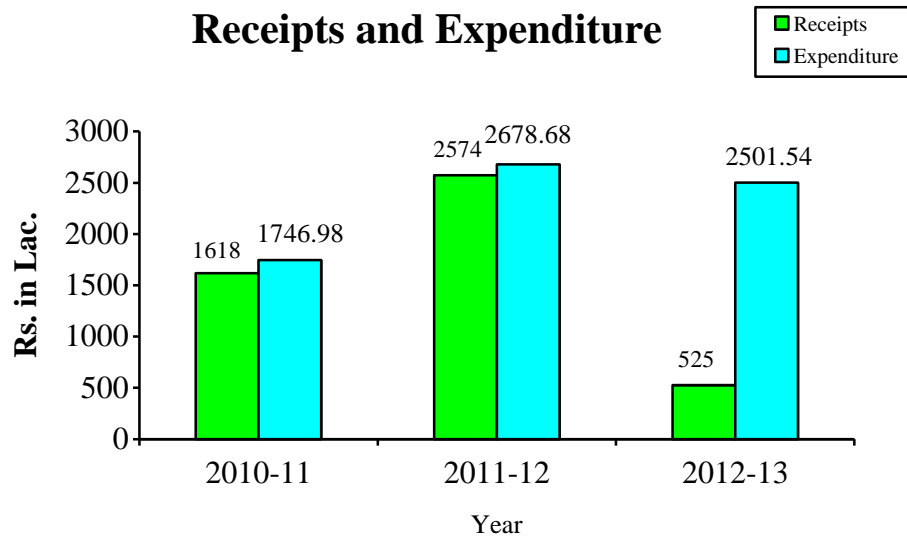

VI. RECRUITMENT

6.1 The primary work of the Public Service Commission is to recruit personnel for various service/posts of the State Government. So far as the matter of recruitment of competent candidates for various services is concerned the Public Service Commissions are required to maintain

high efficiency, quality, objectivity and transparency. It's a challenge for the Commission to complete the recruitment procedure in a specific time limit. There are so many stages of the recruitment from requisition to recommendation. Numbers of aspirants are being increased. To meet the increasing number of candidates in various examinations, latest techniques and better management is required. Efforts have been made to reduce the time lag between requisitions to recommendation. Online Application System has been introduced by the Commission.

- 6.2 The recruitment process is completed either by Direct recruitment through Interview alone or Competitive Examination with or without Interview as per the provisions as laid down in the concerning Service Rules. In case, where large number of aspirants applies for the direct recruitment posts, the Commission conducts screening tests to short list the candidates.
- 6.3 **Interview Boards:-** During the year under report, the Commission interviewed 4640 (Examination + Interview) candidates for different posts/services by constituting 229 Boards. The number of days on which one and two Boards interviewed the candidates were 147 and 82 respectively.

A- By competitive examination with or without interview:

- 6.4 The Commission conducts 24 categories of competitive examinations for recruitment to various posts/services on receipt of requisitions from the Government, which are as follows: -

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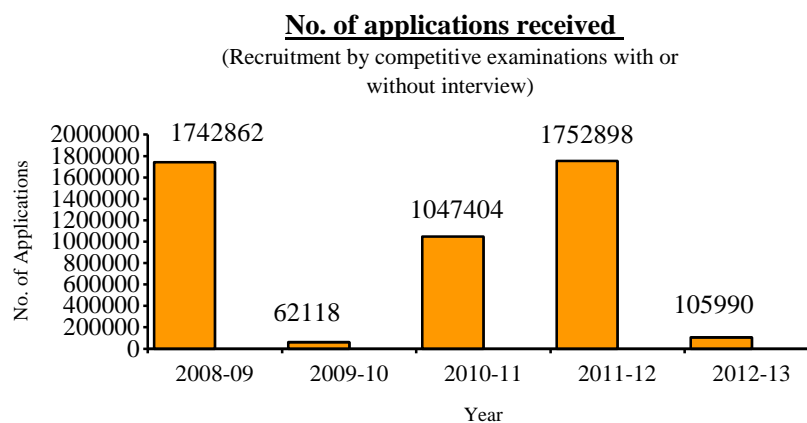

6.9 During the year under report, recruitment was completed in respect of 55 requisitions involving 1141 posts. The details of selections done relating to the above requisitions as given in Appendix VII-C (Item Number 1 to 55) are summarized in the following table:



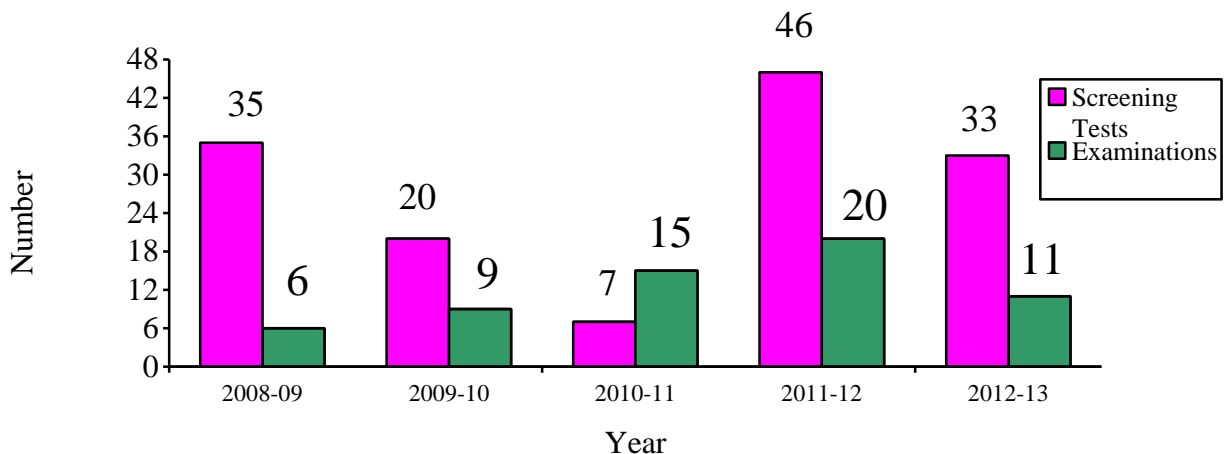

6.10 During the year under report 26 requisitions involving 600 posts were received by the Commission. Of which 10 requisitions involving 127 posts were under correspondence with the Government being found defective in respect of Educational Qualifications, Age Limit, Method of Recruitment and Reservation. 4 requisitions involving 59 posts being found defective were returned to the respective Departments. Action for Advertisement was thus left for remaining 12 requisitions involving 414 posts, out of which 11 requisitions involving 411 posts were notified during the year and 1 requisition involving 3 posts was pending notification and under process.

6.11 Department wise/category wise break-up of requisitions advertised against requisitions received during the year 2012-13 is shown in Appendix VII-B.

- 6.12 During the period under report, the Commission recommended names of 18 candidates from reserve lists. Details of which are given in Appendix 7-H.
- 6.13 Statement showing the number of Engineering, Medical, Technical and non-Technical posts for which requisitions were received during the year 2012-13 is given in Appendix VII-A
- 6.14 **Screening tests :-** The Commission conducted 33 screening tests for short listing the candidates in respect of 915 posts of various departments. The details of screening tests conducted are given in Appendix VII-E.

- 6.15 List of posts advertised but selections remained incomplete during the year under report has been given in Appendix VII – D.
- 6.16 Details of posts for which no candidate found suitable and no any candidate applied are given in Appendix VII-G and VII-I respectively.
- 6.17 **State Eligibility Test for Lectureship (S.E.T.) :-** During the year under report, SET Examination, 2012 were held on 26-08-2012. Number of total application received and candidates present in the examination were 83,678 and 63,037 respectively. This examination was conducted for 28 subjects at Ajmer, Bharatpur, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Kota, Udaipur and Jaipur centers. Result of the examination was under process till the end of the year.

VII. REFORMS IN THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS

- 7.1. **Review, Revision and Redrafting of syllabi :-** Review, revision and redrafting of syllabi of various subjects prescribed for various competitive examinations and screening tests conducted by the Commission, have become a regular process. Eminent subject-experts were invited to participate in the workshops/seminars organized by the Commission, for this purpose.
- 7.2. During the year under report, the syllabi for the following 5 categories of the posts/subjects were reviewed or new framed by the Commission by assigning the work to eminent subject experts :-

VIII. RESERVATION FOR SC, ST, OBC, S.B.C., P.D. AND WOMAN CANDIDATES

(a) Recruitment by examination with or without interview :

8.1. Reservation of 16, 12, 21 and 1 *per cent* of posts has been fixed for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Class and Special Backward Class respectively (for OBC's w.e.f. 28/09/93) (For SBC's w.e.f. 25/08/2009). 30% reservation of vacancies has been fixed for woman candidates in direct recruitment. Reservation of vacancies for woman candidates is to be adjusted proportionately in the respective category to which they belong and the reservation shall be treated as horizontal (for woman candidates vide Notification dated 7/06/99 w.e.f. 01/04/99). Similarly, 3 *per cent* reservation of vacancies has been fixed for Physically Disabled candidates in direct recruitment, which shall be treated as horizontal and adjusted from among all categories (reservation for Physically Disabled candidates fixed vide Notification dated 22-09-2000 w.e.f. 22-09-2000.)

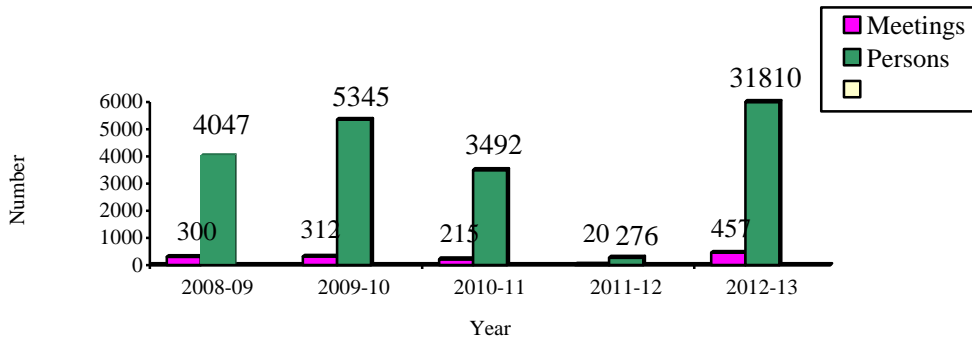

IX. DEPARTMENTAL PROMOTION COMMITTEES AND OTHER COMMITTEES

- 9.1. The Commission held meetings of Departmental Promotion Committees on 304 occasions to regularize *ad hoc*/temporary appointments of posts involving 18768 persons, of which large number of cases pertained to the Secondary Education Department (80) and Medical & Health Department (53).
- 9.2. The Meetings of Review/Regular Committees were held on 41 occasions to regularize 3079 persons of which large number of cases pertained to the Public Health Engineering Department (7) and Finance Department (6).
- 9.3. The meetings of Review Committees were also held on 82 occasions for regularizing 8521 persons, of which large number of cases pertained to the Medical Education (12) and Secondary Education Department (10).
- 9.4 Meetings of Screening Committees were also held on 30 occasions for regularizing 1442 persons.

X. EXTENSION IN THE TERM OF TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS

- 10.1. A mention is made every year of the *ad hoc*/temporary appointments referred to the Commission for obtaining their concurrence to the extension in the terms of temporary appointments. The Government had also been apprised of the alarming position in regard to the cases of *ad hoc*/temporary appointments lasting over 5 years and in some cases even 10 years with the intention that the Government might take expeditious steps for regularizing those cases. The position of *ad hoc*/temporary appointments still remained unchanged, in spite of the fact that many Departmental Promotion Committees meetings were held during the current year for making selection by promotion. An illustrative list of long outstanding cases of such *ad hoc*/temporary appointments is being given in Appendix IX.
- 10.2 During the period under report, the Commission accorded their concurrence for extension in the term of temporary appointments in respect of 394 persons appointed against the post to be filled against direct quota recruitment as per the details given in Appendix-XI.
- 10.3 The number of such *ad hoc*/temporary appointees 613 during the year, while it was 289 in the previous year. The Government will take appropriate action in order to put a check on such appointments.
- 10.4 During the period under report, the Commission accorded their concurrence for extension the terms of temporary appointments in respect of 219 persons appointed against the posts to be filled by promotion quota as per the details given in Appendix-X.
- 10.5 Even after specific directions of the Government for sending the requisitions containing clear and complete information in the prescribed format, some of the appointing authorities failed to furnish complete information in the prescribed format, while referring cases of urgent/temporary/*ad hoc* appointments to the Commission for obtaining their concurrence. As a result, the cases have been delayed inordinately. During the year under report, 07 (Seven) incomplete references involving 85 persons and three incomplete reference pending since previous years involving 589 persons appointed against promotion quota and direct recruitment quota posts were referred to the Commission. The list available in Appendix-XII.
- 10.6 It was noticed by the Commission that some of the appointment authorities failed to get regularized the *ad hoc*/temporary appointments in time. The number of belated reference made by such departments is given in Appendix-XIII

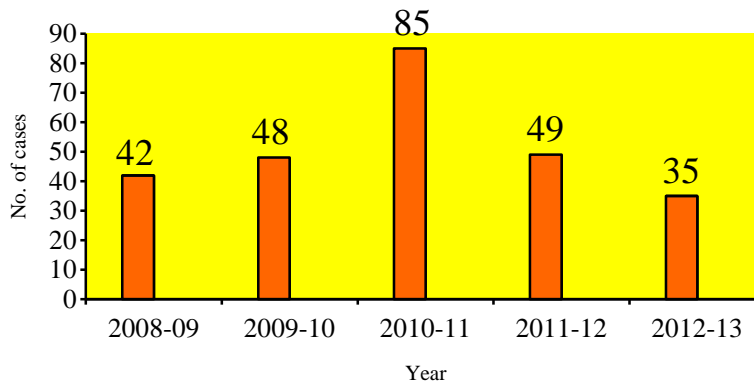
11.1. No case of irregular appointment made by the departments was observed by the Commission during the year under report.

XII. DISCIPLINARY CASES AND APPEALS

12.1. **Disciplinary cases** :- 16 cases were pending with the Commission on 1-4-2012. During the year under report, the Commission received 34 cases, making a total of 50 cases; the Commission tendered their advice on 35 cases. At the close of the year, there were 15 cases pending with the Commission, of which 1 case was under clarification with the Government and 10 cases were under consideration of the Commission. Three cases received during the current year and One case received during the previous year were out of the purview of the Commission on which advice of the Commission was not tendered and returned to the Government. Thus, the balance 10 cases remained under consideration of the Commission, at the end of the year under report.

12.2. The Government accepted the advice tendered by the Commission in 06 cases (i.e. 01 case of current year + 05 cases pertained to the previous year(s)).

- 12.3 **Appeal/Review D.E. Cases** :- During the year under report, no any case of Review D.E. was received by the Commission. No case of Appeal was received by the Commission.
- 12.4 **Litigations/Writs** :- During the year under report, 1163 cases in addition to 2657 cases of previous years of Civil suits /Complaints/ Writ petitions/appeals/D.B. special appeals/S.L.P. filed in the Civil Courts/High Court/Service Tribunal/Supreme Court/State Consumer Protection Commission/ District Consumer Forum etc. were pending, thus, making a total of 3820 cases. During the period under review, the number of cases decided by the various courts was 940. Thus, in all, 2880 cases were awaiting decision in the various Courts.

XIII. SERVICE RULES

- 13.1 During the year under report, draft amendments to 218 Rules/Schedules relating to various Services were referred to the Commission for their comments, which were conveyed in all Draft Amendments. Details thereof have been given in Appendix XIV.
- 13.2 During the year under report the Commission also examined and dealt with Draft of two new Rules, which is also mentioned in Appendix XIV-A.
- 13.3 The Government promulgated New Service Rules and amendments in 38 Service Rules / Regulations as shown in Appendix XV.
- 13.4 During the year under report, the Commission dealt with one case of recognition of Degree/Diploma/Certificate etc. Details are given in Appendix- XVII.
- 13.5 During the year under report, the Commission received 3 cases of Compassionate Appointment of Dependents of the Deceased/ Permanently incapacitated Armed Forces Service Personnel/Para Military Personnel. These cases were examined under the provisions of the relevant Service Rules out of which in one case Commission's concurrence was conveyed, another one case was remained under consideration of the Commission and another one case was remained under correspondence with the Government till the end of the year under report. The details of these cases are given in Appendix XVI.
- 13.6 Besides these, during the year under Report the Government has issued Notification No. F.2(5) DOP/A-II/90 dated 30.10.12 pertaining to amendments in the Rajasthan Statistical Subordinate Service Rules, 1971 without prior concurrence of the Commission.
- 13.7 The Government was asked vide office letter dated 12.02.13 to kindly intimate the reasons/circumstances for issuing of the said Notification without prior approval of the Commission.
- 13.8 The Government have clarified their position in this behalf vide their letter dated 28-02-13 and the Commission has considered the Government views and they have decided to convey partly concurrence of the Commission in the matter and partly concurrence was conveyed to the Government vide this office letter dated 04.04.13.

- 13.9 During the year under Report the Commission has refused to concur to the proposed amendments in the Rajasthan Agriculture Subordinate Service Rules, 1978 vide this office letter dated 11.07.12.
- 13.10 A letter was received from the Hon'ble Chief Secretary, Government of Rajasthan, Jaipur wherein he has requested to reconsider the stand taken by the Commission and permit removal of Interview as part of recruitment process only for Rajasthan Subordinate Services.
- 13.11 This matter was considered by the full Commission in its meeting held on 26.09.12 and they decided to inform to the Hon'ble Chief Secretary that this matter may be referred to the Committee constituted by the Government vide their letter No. F.17(16)Karmik/Ka-2/10 dated 07.06.11
- 13.12 During the year under Report the Government has issued Notification dated 20.03.12 pertaining to amendments in the Rajasthan Civil Services (Special Selection and Special Conditions of Service of Project Officers and Research Officers in the Department of Science and Technology) Rules, 1986.
- 13.13 The Government was asked vide this office letter dated 03.07.12 to kindly intimate the reasons/circumstances for issuing of the said Notification.
- 13.14 The DOP (A-II) informed that the posts included in the Rules are to be filled on the basis of tenure as such it is not necessary to consult the Commission and has requested to convey the comments of the Commission.
- 13.15 Vide this office letter dated 02.11.12 the Government was informed that the Notification dated 20.03.12 was issued under the provisions of Article 309 of the Constitution of India hence, Commission's concurrence is necessary before issuing of the Notification as per the past practice.
- 13.16 The Government was further informed to intimate the factual position in this behalf. The reply is still awaited from the Government.
- 13.17 During the year under Report the Commission has accorded their partly concurrence to the proposed amendments in the Rajasthan Ayurvedic, Unani, Homoeopathy and Naturopathy Service Rules, 1973 vide this office letter dated 13.02.13

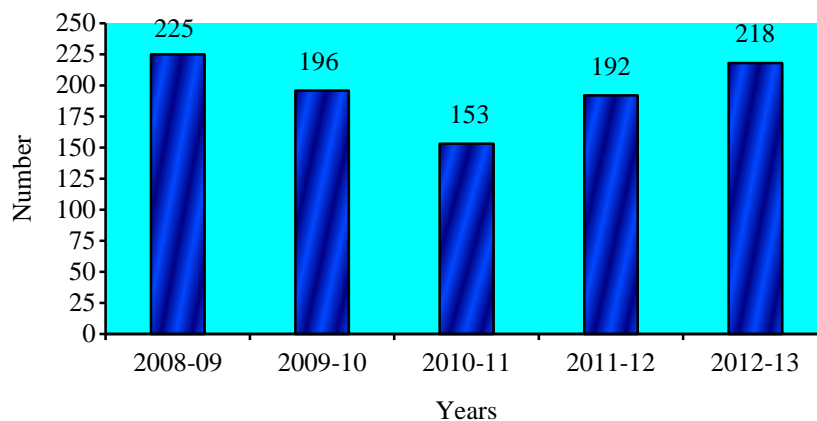

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APPENDICES

APPENDIX I

Functions of the Commission

The functions exercised by the Rajasthan Public Service Commission are laid down in Article 320 of the Constitution of India.

The Public Service Commission shall be consulted :-

(a) On all matters relating to methods of recruitment to civil services and for civil posts;

(b) On the principles to be followed in making appointments to civil service and posts and in making promotions and transfers from one service to another and on the suitability of candidates for such appointments, promotions or transfers;

(c) On all disciplinary matters affecting a person serving under State Government in civil capacity, including memorials or petitions relating to such matters;

(d) On any claim by or in respect of a person who is serving or has served under the State Government, in a civil capacity that any costs incurred by him in defending legal proceeding instituted against him in respect of acts done or purporting to be done in the execution of his duty should be paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State;

(e) On any claim for the award of a pension in respect of injuries sustained by a person while serving under the State Government in a civil capacity and any question as to the amount of any such award; and

(f) Any other matter referred to them by the Government.

It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services and Posts, or the principles to be followed in making appointments to such posts, or the suitability of the candidates for such appointments :-

Unless otherwise provided in the relevant Service Rules for recruitment to any post in a Service, when the appointment is to be made to any post -

- 1 in Ministerial Service, or
- 2 in Subordinate Service or State Service whether technical or non-technical starting with an initial Grade Pay of “Rs. 3200/- or less per month” as per R.P.S.C. (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1951.
