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I. THE COMMISSION

The State of Rajasthan was formed as a result of the merger of the erstwhile, princely States situated in Rajputana and Part- 'C' State of Ajmer-Merwara. At the time of formation of Rajasthan the institution of Public Service Commission existed in only three of the twenty-two covenanting States, viz. Jaipur, Jodhpur and Bikaner.

The successor administration after the merger of the princely States promulgated on 16th August, 1949 an ordinance establishing, the Rajasthan Public Service Commission, but it came into existence from 22nd December, 1949 after issuing notification regarding appointment of Hon'ble Chairman and Members of the Commission.

The provisions regarding Public Service Commission for the Union and for the State and appointment & term of office of Members have been laid down in Article 315 & 316 respectively in the Constitution of India.

- 1.1 The functions of the Commission as laid down in Article 320 of the Constitution of India are given in Appendix-I.

It means the number of Members of the Commission had increased to seven instead of five.





3.1 The Secretariat of the Commission is located in its own building at Ghooghra Ghati, Jaipur Road, Ajmer.


IV. RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURE

VI. RECRUITMENT

- 6.1 The primary work of the Public Service Commission is to recruit personnel for various service/posts of the State Government. So far as the matter of recruitment of competent candidates for various services is concerned the Public Service Commissions are required to maintain high efficiency, quality, objectivity and transparency. It's a challenge for the Commission to complete the recruitment procedure in a specific time limit. There are so many stages of the recruitment from requisition to recommendation. Numbers of aspirants are being increased. To meet the increasing number of candidates in various examinations, latest techniques and better management is required. Efforts have been made to reduce the time lag between requisitions to recommendation. Online Application System has been introduced by the Commission.
- 6.2 The recruitment process is completed either by Direct recruitment through Interview alone or Competitive Examination with or without Interview as per the provisions as laid down in the concerning Service Rules. In case, where large number of aspirants applies for the direct recruitment posts, the Commission conducts screening tests to short list the candidates.
- 6.3 <u>Interview Boards</u>:- During the year under report, the Commission interviewed 3631 (Examination + Interview) candidates for different posts/services by constituting 246 Boards. The number of days on which one and two Boards interviewed the candidates was 238 and 08 respectively.

Thus making a total of 26 requisitions involving 31224 posts were pending to be notified. Out of which 14 requisitions involving 30382 posts were






6.9 **Candidates debarred from the Commission's examinations**



6.11 11 requisitions involving 130 posts were pending notification at the commencement of the year. During the year under report 91 requisitions involving 2629 posts were received by the Commission. Thus making a total of 102 requisition involving 2759 posts, of which 57 requisitions involving 1181 posts were under correspondence with the Government being found defective in respect of Educational Qualifications, Age Limit, Method of Recruitment and Reservation, etc remained pending. 3 requisitions involving 285 posts being found defective were returned to the respective Departments. Remaining 42 requisitions involving 1293 posts were notified during the year.

- 6.15 Screening tests:- The Commission conducted 13 screening tests for short listing the candidates in respect of 282 posts of various departments. The details of screening tests conducted are given in Appendix VII-E.



- 6.16 List of posts advertised but selections remained incomplete during the year under report has been given in Appendix VII D.
- 6.17 Details of posts for which no candidate found suitable and no any candidate applied are given in Appendix VII-G and VII-I respectively.
- 6.18 **State Eligibility Test for Lectureship (S.E.T.):-** The State Eligibility Test for Lecturer was held on 26-08-2012. The result was declared on 31-07-2013 after approval of Moderation Committee. Hon'ble Chairman along-with 7 eminent members of moderation committee attended the meeting on 30-07-2013 in the committee room of R.P.S.C., Ajmer. It was followed by steering committee/advisory Committee meeting. The Committee authorized the Commission to decide the dates of SET- 2013 examination. The UGC New Delhi has permitted to conduct examination in Rajasthani subject also.

- 6.19 It was a great achievement for Commission. Now RPSC is conducting SET-2013 examination in 29 subject's. The Notification for conducting SET-2013 was issued vide dated 23-10-2013 and last date for submission online application was 30-11-2013, Total 58,016 application were received. The RPSC has conducted work-shops of experts for framing questions. Eminent Experts from different states have been invited in the work-shop.
- 6.20 All eligible qualified candidates who have requested for provisional SET- 2012 Certificate have been issued. The RPSC plans to issue Original Certificate through E-governance/Kiosk, in near future.
- 6.21 Due to non-availability of examination centers and general election, the schedule for SET examination could not be finalized. The Commission plans to conduct the examination as soon as examination centers are available.
- 6.22 To update the panel of Experts letters to Vice-Chancellor's within state and outside states were sent. Hon'ble V.C.'s were requested to nominate at least 02 experts in each discipline.
- 6.23 There are many subject's which are not covered in Life Sciences by the UGC in the NET and by RPSC in SET examination. These subjects were identified by the Commission. Member-Secretary took this matter personally with Deputy Secretary, UGC (NET). The proposed subjects to be included in future in Life Sciences are:-
 - 1. Master of Science in the discipline of Animal Biotechnology.
 - 2. Master of Science Biosciences.
 - 3. Master of Science Biosciences (Plant Science).
 - 4. Master of Science in Bioinformatics (MSCBI).
 - 5. Master of Veterinary Science in Animal Biotechnology.
 - 6. Master of Science in Plant Biotechnology.
 - 7. Master of Science Ecology and Environment.
 - 8. M.Tech in Biotechnology.

VII. REFORMS IN THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS

7.1. **Review, Revision and Redrafting of syllabi:-** Review, revision and redrafting of syllabi of various subjects prescribed for various competitive examinations and screening tests conducted by the Commission, have become a regular process. Eminent subject-experts were invited to participate in the workshops/seminars organized by the Commission, for this purpose.

VIII. RESERVATION FOR SC, ST, OBC, S.B.C., P.D. AND WOMAN CANDIDATES

(a) Recruitment by examination with or without interview :

8.1. Reservation of 16, 12, 21 and 1 *per cent* of posts has been fixed for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Class and Special Backward Class respectively (for OBC's w.e.f. 28/09/93) (For SBC's w.e.f. 25/08/2009). 30% reservation of vacancies has been fixed for woman candidates in direct recruitment. Reservation of vacancies for woman candidates is to be adjusted proportionately in the respective category to which they belong and the reservation shall be treated as horizontal (for woman candidates vide Notification dated 7/06/99 w.e.f. 01/04/99). Similarly, *3 per cent* reservation of vacancies has been fixed for Physically Disabled candidates in direct recruitment, which shall be treated as horizontal and adjusted from among all categories (reservation for Physically Disabled candidates fixed vide Notification dated 22-09-2000 w.e.f. 22-09-2000.)



IX. DEPARTMENTAL PROMOTION COMMITTEES AND OTHER COMMITTEES

- 9.1. The Commission held meetings of Departmental Promotion Committees on 175 occasions to regularize *ad hoc*/temporary appointments of posts involving 5288 persons, of which large number of cases pertained to the Agriculture Department (25), Home Department/Medical & Health Department/Ayurved Department/Mines Department (14) and Police Forensic Lab (11).
- 9.2. The meetings of Review Committees were also held on 69 occasions for regularizing 2198 persons, of which large number of cases pertained to the Medical & Health/Ayurved Department (11) and Agriculture Department (07).
- 9.3. Meetings of Screening Committees were also held on 40 occasions for regularizing 2129 persons.

X. EXTENSION IN THE TERM OF TEMPORARY <u>APPOINTMENTS</u>


- 10.1. A mention was made in the previous year's report in regard to the cases of *ad hoc*/temporary appointments referred to the Commission for obtaining their concurrence to the extension of their terms of temporary appointments. The Government has also been apprised of the alarming position in regard to the cases of *ad hoc*/temporary appointments lasting over 5 years and in some cases even 10 years with the intention that the Government might take expeditious steps for regularizing those cases. The position of *ad hoc*/temporary appointments still remained unchanged, in spite of the fact that many Departmental Promotion Committees meetings were held during the year for making selection by promotion. An illustrative list of long outstanding cases of such *ad hoc*/temporary appointments has again being given in Appendix IX.
- 10.2 During the period under report, the Commission accorded their concurrence for extension in the terms of temporary appointments in respect of 287 persons appointed against the post to be filled against Direct recruitment quota as per the details given in Appendix-XI.
- 10.3 The number of such *ad hoc/*temporary appointees were 391 during the year, while it was 613 in the previous year. The Government will take appropriate action in order to put a check on such appointments.
- 10.4 During the period under report, the Commission accorded their concurrence for extension in the terms of temporary appointments in respect of 104 persons appointed against the posts to be filled by Promotion quota as per the details given in Appendix-X.
- 10.5 Some of the appointing authorities failed to furnish complete information in the prescribed proforma while referring the cases of urgent/temporary appointments to the Commission for obtaining their concurrence. The result is that the Commission had to make a back reference before considering the case for conveying their concurrence. During the year under report two incomplete references, involving 16 persons and Six incomplete references pending since previous year's involving 600 persons appointed against promotion quota and direct recruitment quota posts were referred to the Commission. The list available in Appendix-XII.

XI. IRREGULAR APPOINTMENTS

11.1. No case of irregular appointment made by the departments was observed by the Commission during the year under report.

XII. DISCIPLINARY CASES AND APPEALS

- 12.1. **Disciplinary cases** :- 14 cases were pending with the Commission on 01-4-2013. During the year under report, the Commission received 24 new cases, making a total of 38 cases; the Commission tendered their advice on 27 cases i.e. 10 cases received in previous year's and on 17 cases received in the current year.
- 12.2 Out of 14 cases of the previous year's, advice tendered on 10 cases, 01 case was deemed closed due to death of the accused officer, 02 cases were returned to the Government for proper record and 01 case returned to the Government in compliance with the Hon'ble Court.
- 12.3 Out of 24 cases of the current year, advice tendered on 17 cases, 01 case of Dr. Manish Kumar Malick, Veterinary Officer returned to the Government in connection with their letter Dt. 01-01-14.
- 12.4 Advice tendered in the month of April, 2014 on 04 cases received during the current year are to be shown in the Annual Report of the year 2013-14.
- 12.5 Hence, total number of cases on which advice tendered by the Commission is 31.
- 12.6 At the close of the year, there were 02 cases pending with the Commission, of which 1 case was under clarification with the Government and 01 case was under consideration of the Commission.



Advice tendered on D.E. cases


- 12.7 <u>Appeal/Review D.E. Cases</u>:- During the year under report, no any case of Review D.E. was received by the Commission. No case of Appeal was received by the Commission.
- 12.8 <u>Litigations/Writs</u> :- During the year under report, 1060 cases in addition to 2880 cases of previous years of Civil suits/Complaints/ Writ petitions/appeals/D.B. special appeals/S.L.P. filed in the Civil Courts/High Court/Service Tribunal/Supreme Court/State Consumer Protection Commission/ District Consumer Forum etc. were pending, thus, making a total of 3940 cases. During the period under review, the number of cases decided by the various courts was 915. Thus, in all, 3025 cases were awaiting decision in the various Courts.

XIII. SERVICE RULES

- 13.1 Draft Amendments to **492** Rules/Schedules relating to various Services were referred to the Commission for their comments which were conveyed in all Draft Amendments. Details thereof have been given in Appendix-XIII.
- 13.2 During the year under Report the Commission also examined and dealt with the Draft of **05** New Rules. Details thereof have been given in Appendix- XIV.
- 13.3 During the year under report the Government has promulgated New Service Rules and amendments in **44** Service Rules/Regulations as shown in Appendix-XV.
- 13.4 During the year under Report the Commission dealt with **one** case of recognition of Degree/Diploma/Certificate etc. Details thereof have been given in Appendix-XVII.
- 13.5 During the year under Report Commission received **one** case of Compassionate Appointment of Dependents of Deceased Permanently incapacitated Armed Forces Service Personnel/Para Military Personnel. This case was examined under the relevant Rules and this case was remained under correspondence with the Government till the end of the year under report. Detail of this case is shown in Appendix-XVI.
- 13.6 Besides the above one case regarding filling up of 200 vacant posts of Clerk Grade-II by direct recruitment through Rajasthan Public Service Commission for JDA (Jaipur Development Authority) under the provisions of the Jaipur Development Authority Staff (Recruitment and General Conditions) Regulations, 1984 was

received. This case was submitted before the Full Commission's meeting for their consideration.

- 13.7 After their kind consideration it was decided that principle concurrence of the commission for filling up of 200 vacant posts of Clerk Grade-II by direct recruitment through Rajasthan Public Service Commission for JDA may be accorded and conveyed to the Government with certain conditions contained in our letter dated 11/10/2013.
- 13.8 During the year under Report the Government in the DOP has issued Notifications dated 13/05/2013 and 19/06/2013 pertaining to amendments in the Rajasthan Ayurvedic, Unani, Homoeopathy and Naturopathy Service Rules, 1973 and they have also issued Notification dated 13/05/2013 pertaining to amendment in the Rajasthan Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1951.
- 13.9 Partly concurrence of the Commission was conveyed to the Government to the proposed amendments in the Rajasthan Ayurvedic, Unani, Homoeopathy and Naturopathy Service Rules, 1973. The Commission has refused to concur to the amendments in the Rajasthan Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1951 vide this office letter dated 08/01/2014.
- 13.10 The Government was asked vide this office letter dated 08/01/2014 to kindly intimate the reasons for issuing of the said Notifications, but the reply is still awaited from the Government till the year under report.

APPENDICES

<u>APPENDIX I</u> Functions of the Commission

The functions exercised by the Rajasthan Public Service Commission are laid down in Article 320 of the Constitution of India.

The Public Service Commission shall be consulted:-

(a) On all matters relating to methods of recruitment to civil services and for civil posts;

(b) On the principles to be followed in making appointments to civil service and posts and in making promotions and transfers from one service to another and on the suitability of candidates for such appointments, promotions or transfers;

(c) On all disciplinary matters affecting a person serving under State Government in civil capacity, including memorials or petitions relating to such matters;

(d) On any claim by or in respect of a person who is serving or has served under the State Government, in a civil capacity that any costs incurred by him in defending legal proceeding instituted against him in respect of acts done or purporting to be done in the execution of his duty should be paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State;

(e) On any claim for the award of a pension in respect of injuries sustained by a person while serving under the State Government in a civil capacity and any question as to the amount of any such award; and

(f) Any other matter referred to them by the Government.

It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services and Posts, or the principles to be followed in making appointments to such posts, or the suitability of the candidates for such appointments :-

Unless otherwise provided in the relevant Service Rules for recruitment to any post in a Service, when the appointment is to be made to any post -

- 1 in Ministerial Service, or
- 2 in Subordinate Service or State Service whether technical or non-technical starting with an initial Grade Pay of "Rs. 3600/- or less per month" as per R.P.S.C. (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1951.

APPENDIX II Profiles of Honourable Chairman and Honourable Members of the Commission

1. Dr. Habeeb Khan Gauran, IPS (Retd.) : (M.Sc., Ph.D.)

Dr. Gauran was born on 15 August, 1957 at Didwana, Distt. Nagaur, Rajasthan in the house of Late Shri Bhanwar Khan Sb. He was a bright student and got always first position in the class. He completed his graduation from Govt. Bangur College, Didwana. He got his M.Sc. (Geology) Degree in 1978 from University of Rajasthan, Deptt. of Geology, Udaipur with Gold Medal. In the year 1979 he was selected as Assistant Professor in the University of Rajasthan and did teaching work for nearly four years.

In the year 1982, he was selected in Rajasthan Police Service and awarded by the Best Cadet Award (Sword of Honour) during Basic training in 1983.

In his 30 years career in the Police Service, Dr. Gauran served as Deputy Superintendent of Police, Additional S.P. and Superintendent of Police as a passionate, hard working and honest Police officer. For the commendable services rendered by Dr. Gauran, he was awarded more than 200 commendations and he was honoured three times by the District Administration on Independence Day 1988, 1993 and Republic Day 1994.
