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I. THE COMMISSION

The State of Rajasthan was formed as a result of the merger of the erstwhile, princely States situated in Rajputana and Part- 'C' State of Ajmer-Merwara. At the time of formation of Rajasthan the institution of Public Service Commission existed in only three of the twenty-two covenanting States, viz. Jaipur, Jodhpur and Bikaner.

The successor administration after the merger of the princely States promulgated on 16th August, 1949 an ordinance establishing, the Rajasthan Public Service Commission, which was published on 20th August, 1949 but it came into existence from 22nd December, 1949 after issuing notification regarding appointment of Hon'ble Chairman and Members of the Commission.

The provisions regarding Public Service Commission for the Union and for the State and appointment & term of office of Members have been laid down in Article 315 to 323 in the Constitution of India.

- 1.1 The functions of the Commission as laid down in Article 320 of the Constitution of India are given in Appendix-I.

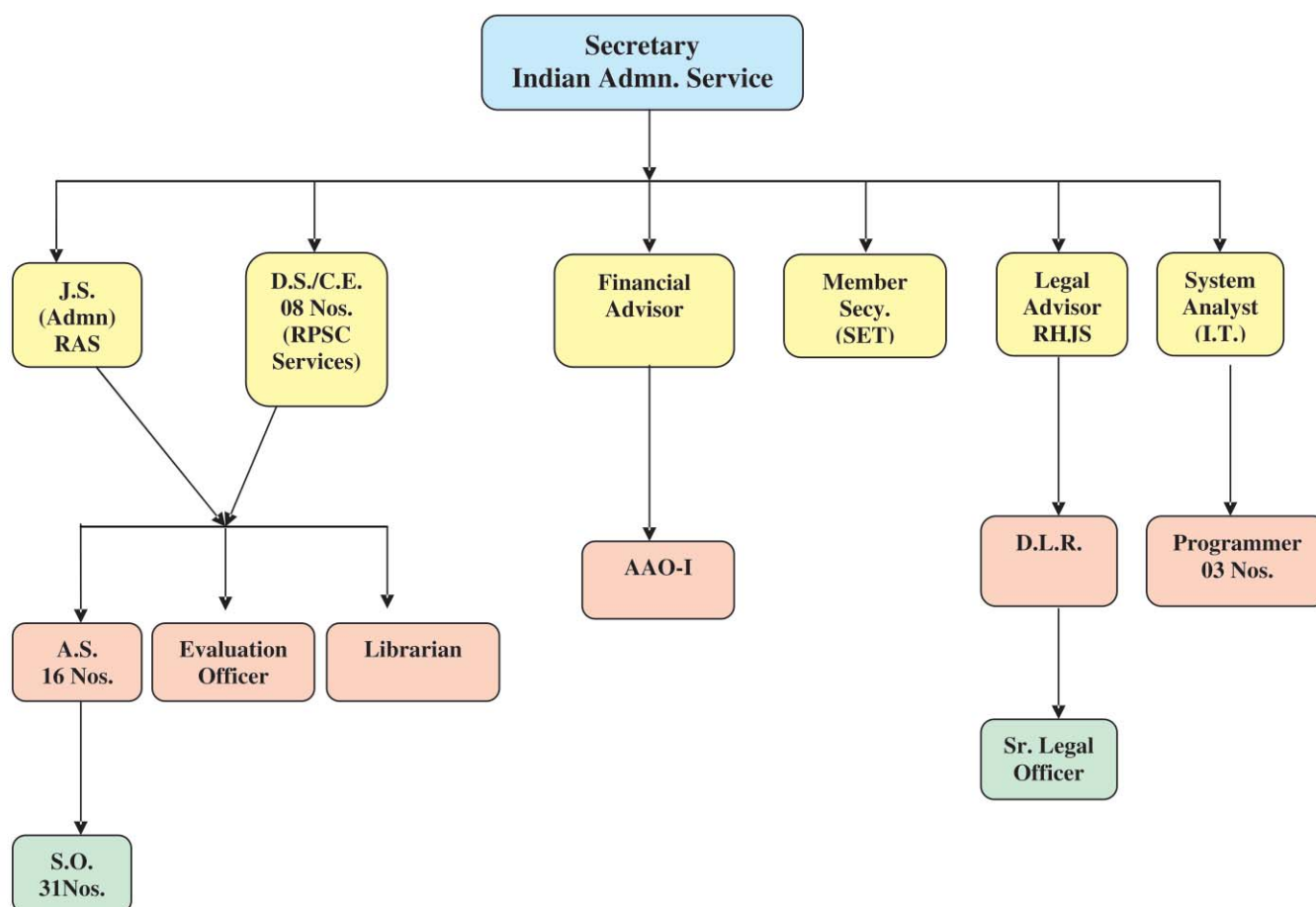

- 1.8 In sub-regulation (1) of regulation-3 of the Rajasthan Public Service Commission (Conditions of Service) Regulations, 1974 for the existing expression "Five", the expression "Seven" was substituted vide Notification No. F.8(4)DOP/A-II/2011 dated 27-06-2011 issued by Department of Personnel (A-2). It means the number of Members of the Commission had increased to seven instead of five.

3.2 Guest House :

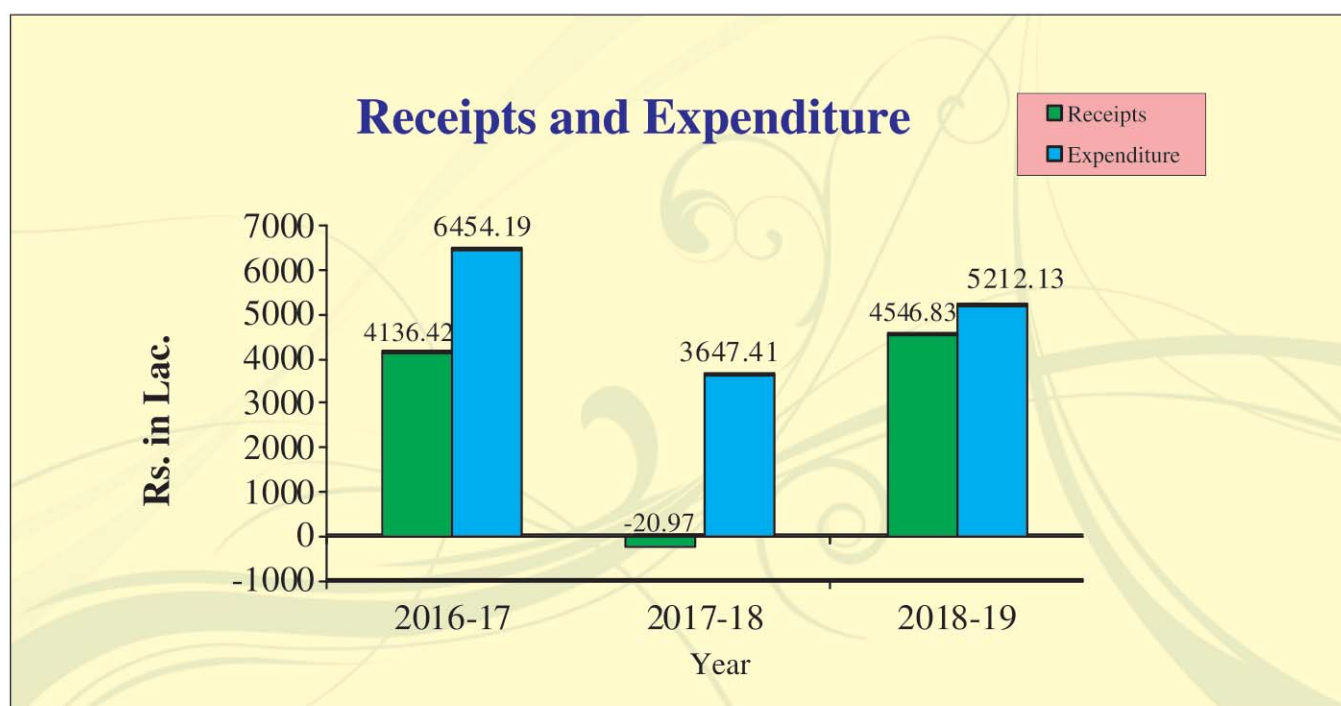

VI. RECRUITMENT

- 6.1 The primary work of the Public Service Commission is to recruit personnel for various service/posts of the State Government. So far as the matter of recruitment of competent candidates for various services is concerned, the Public Service Commissions are required to maintain high efficiency, quality, objectivity and transparency. It's a challenge for the Commission to complete the recruitment procedure in a specific time limit. There are so many stages in the recruitment process from requisition to recommendation. Number of aspirants have increased. To meet the increasing work load of various examinations, latest techniques and better management is required. Efforts have been made to reduce the time lag between requisitions to recommendation. Recently Online Application System through more advanced State integrated Recruitment portal based on Rajasthan Single Sign-On (Raj SSO) has been introduced by the Commission.
- 6.2 The recruitment process is completed either by Direct recruitment through Interview alone or Competitive Examination with or without Interview as per the provisions as laid down in the concerning Service Rules. In case, where large number of aspirants apply for the direct recruitment posts, the Commission conducts screening tests to short list the candidates.

A- By competitive examination with or without Interview:

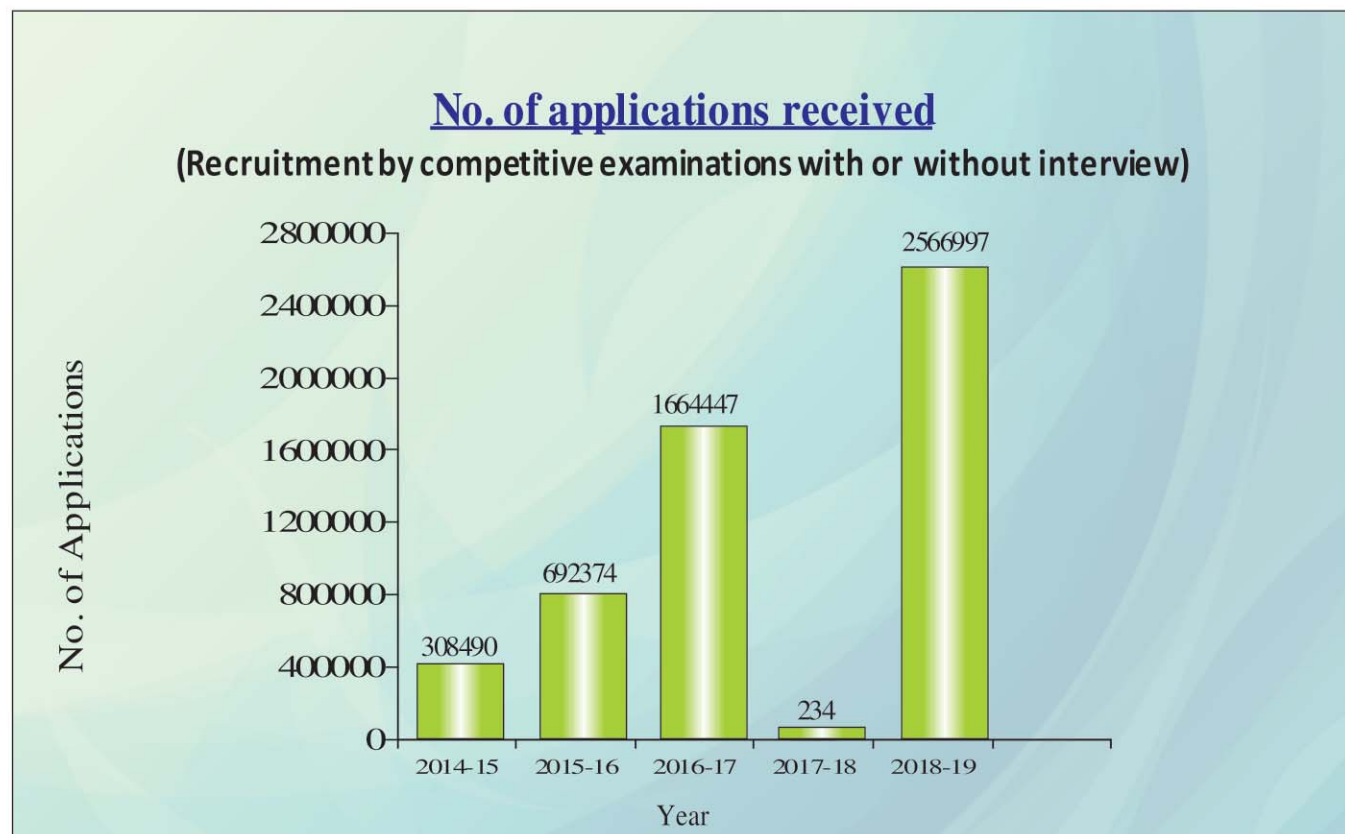
- 6.4 **Details of requisitions and posts advertised:** During the year under report, 12 requisitions involving 2330 posts were pending to be notified at the commencement of the year. 39 requisitions involving 14420 posts were received during the year. Thus making a total of 51 requisitions involving 16750 posts were pending to be notified. Out of which 48 requisitions involving 16266 posts were advertised during the year. 2 requisitions of Forest Department i.e. Assistant Soil Conservation officer (Engg.) and Assistant Soil Conservation Officer (Agriculture), involving 03+01 total 04 posts earlier notified in the year 2011 were withdrawn by the Government after advertisement. 01 (One) requisition of A.En. (Civil), Public works department involving 228 posts which was sent by the Department directly to the Commission was returned to the Government during the year under report. Hence, at the end of the year 02(Two) requisitions of law Department and Sanskrit Education Department involving 256 posts were pending notification with the Commission at the end of the year.

- 6.9 **Details of requisition and posts advertised:-** During the year under report 26 requisitions involving 258 posts were pending notification at the commencement of the year. 75 requisitions involving 1435 posts were received during the year. 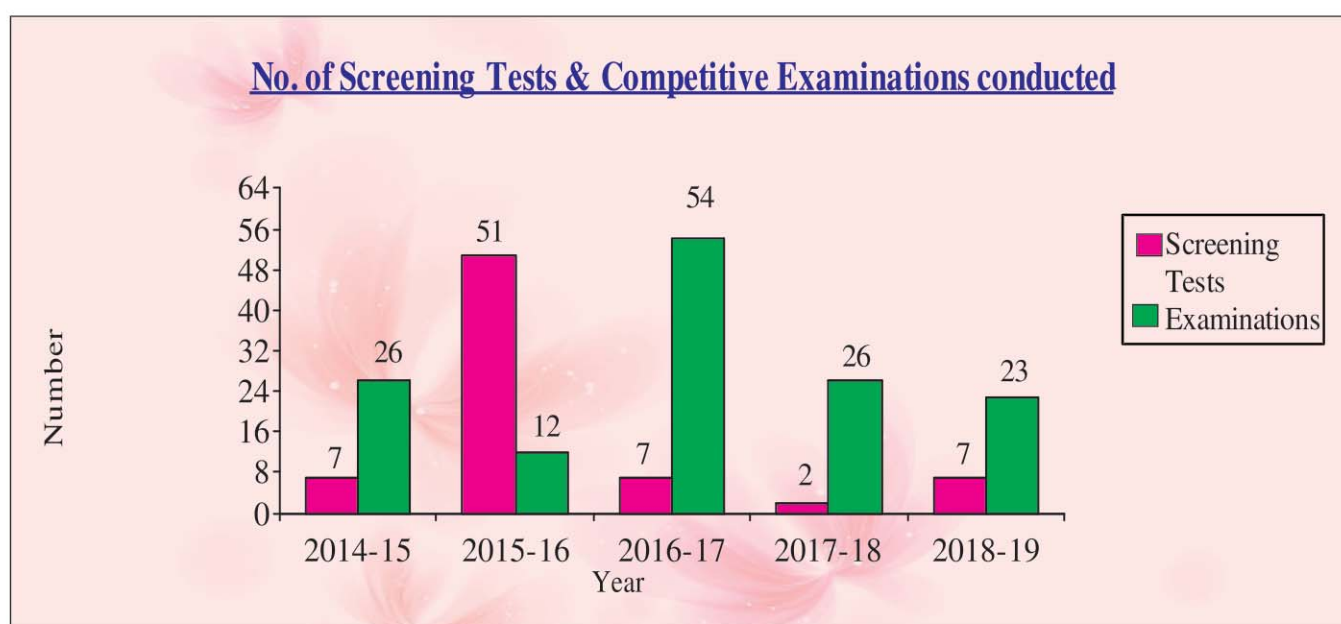

VIII. RESERVATION FOR SC, ST, OBC, M.B.C., E.W.S, P.D. AND WOMAN CANDIDATES (WD & DV)

(a) Recruitment by examination with or without interview :

- 8.1. Reservation of 16, 12, 21, 1 and 10 *per cent* of posts has been fixed for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Class, Most Backward Class and Economically Weaker Section respectively (for OBC's w.e.f. 28/09/93) (For MBC's w.e.f. 13/02/2019) (For EWS w.e.f. 19/02/2019). 30% reservation of vacancies has been fixed for woman candidates in direct recruitment. Reservation of vacancies for woman candidates is to be adjusted proportionately in the respective category (Reservation of 8 and 2 *per cent* of posts has been fixed for candidates belonging to Widow and Divorcee candidates) to which they belong and the reservation shall be treated as horizontal (for woman candidates vide Notification dated 7/06/99 w.e.f. 01/04/99). Similarly, 3 *per cent* reservation of vacancies has been fixed for Physically Disabled candidates in direct recruitment, which shall be treated as horizontal and adjusted from among all categories (reservation for Physically Disabled candidates enforced vide Notification dated 22-09-2000).

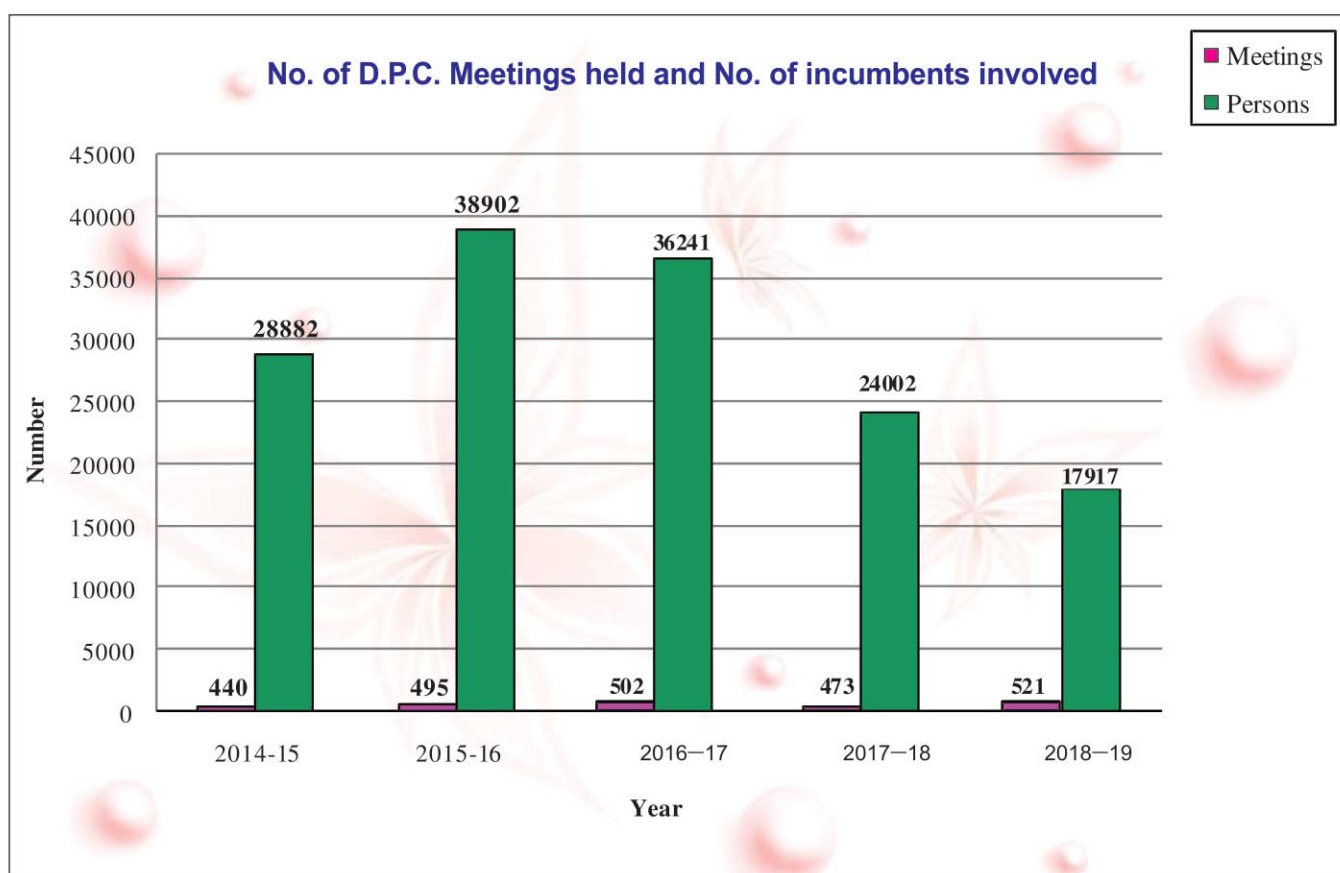

The Commission held meetings of Departmental Promotion Committees on 304 occasions to regularize *ad hoc*/temporary appointments of posts involving 11509 persons, of which highest number of cases pertained to the Primary & Secondary Education Department (126) and other important Department were Agriculture Department (23), Home Department (16), Finance Department (14) and Department of Personnel (12).
- 9.2. The meetings of Review Committees were also held on 163 occasions for regularizing 4998 persons, of which highest number of cases pertained to the Primary and Secondary Education Department (99), Home Department (15), Finance Department (09), Irrigation (Water Resources) Department (07), Department of Personnel (07) and Agriculture Department (06).
- 9.3. Meetings of Screening Committees were also held on 54 occasions for regularizing 1410 persons.



X. EXTENSION IN THE TERM OF TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS

- 10.1. A mention was made in the previous year's report in regard to the cases of *ad hoc*/temporary appointments referred to the Commission for obtaining their concurrence to the extension of their terms to temporary appointments. The Government has also been apprised of the alarming position in regard to the cases of *ad hoc*/temporary appointment lasting over 10 years with the intention that the Government might take expeditious steps for regularizing those cases. The position of *ad hoc*/temporary appointments still remained unchanged. An illustrative list of long outstanding case of such *ad hoc*/temporary appointments has again been mentioned in Appendix IX.
- 10.2 During the period under report, The Commission accorded their concurrence for extension in the terms of Temporary appointments in respect of 641 persons appointed against the posts to be filled by Direct recruitment quota as per the details given in Appendix-XI.
- 10.3 The number of such *ad hoc*/temporary appointees were 769 during the year, while it was 844 in the previous year. The Government will take appropriate action in order to put a check on such appointments.
- 10.4 During the period under report, the Commission accorded their concurrence for extension in the terms of temporary appointments in respect of 128 persons appointed against the posts to be filled by Promotion quota as per the details given in Appendix-X.
- 10.5 Some of the appointing authorities failed to furnish complete information in the prescribed proforma while referring the cases of urgent/temporary appointments to the Commission for obtaining their concurrence. The result is that the Commission had to make a back reference before considering the case for conveying their concurrence. During the year incomplete reference, appointed against Direct Recruitment quota/Promotion quota posts were referred to the Commission. A list there of is available in Appendix-XII.

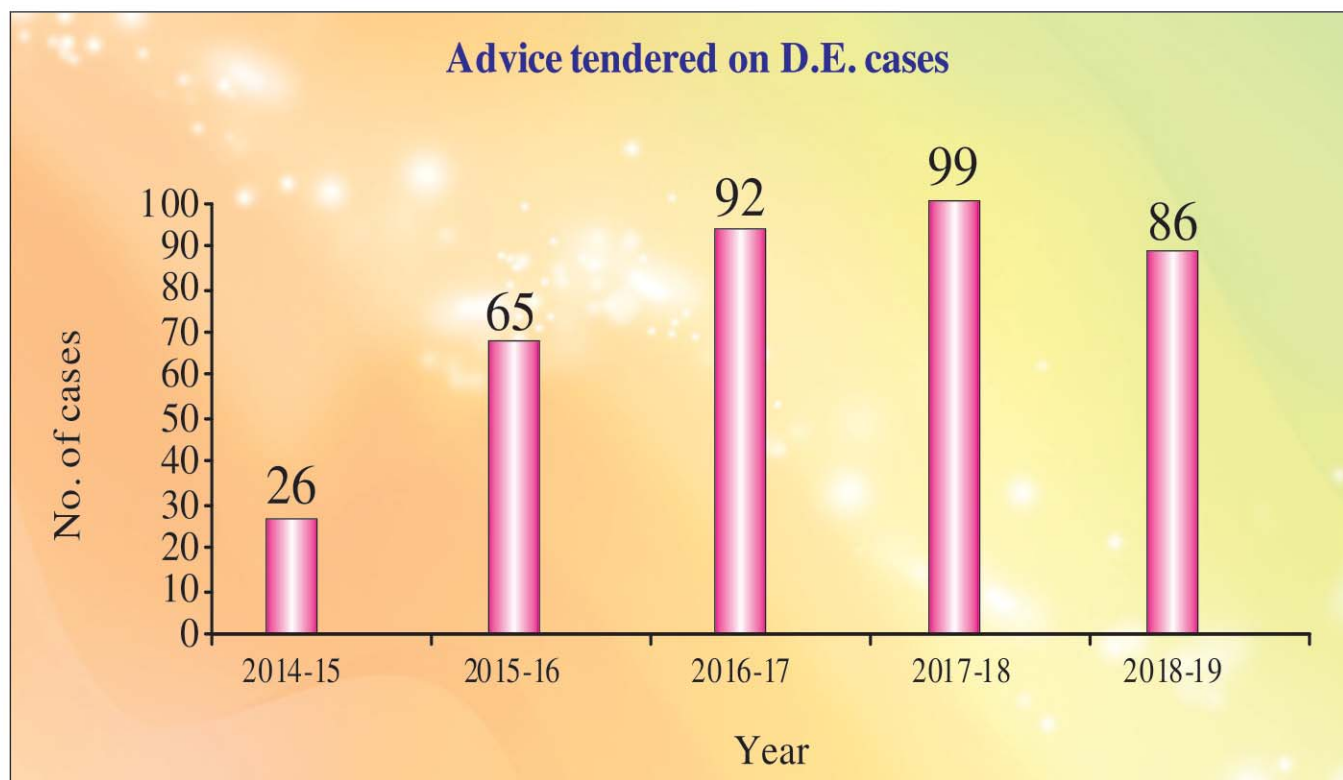
- 11.1 No case of irregular appointment made by the departments was observed by the Commission during the year under report.

XII. DISCIPLINARY CASES AND APPEALS

- 12.1. **Disciplinary cases** :-75 cases were pending with the Commission at the commencement of the year. During the year under report, the Commission received 74 new cases, making a total of 149 cases.
- 12.2 The Commission tendered their advice on 64 cases i.e. which were received in previous year(s). 02 cases returned to the Government which were out of purview of the Commission. Out of balance 09 cases, 07 cases were pending with the Government for want of information and 02 cases were remained under consideration of the Commission.
- 12.3 Out of 74 new cases received during the year, advice tendered on 22 cases. Out of balance 52 cases 13 cases were pending with the Government for want of information and 39 cases were remained under consideration of the Commission.
- 12.4 Hence, total number of cases on which advice tendered by the Commission were 64+22=86.
- 12.5 At the end of the year 61 cases were pending advice of the Commission.
- 12.6 During the year under report the Government conveyed their acceptance in the 78 cases. Out of which 08 cases were related with current year on which the commission tendered their advice during the year 2018-19. The Government also conveyed their acceptance in the 70 cases on which advice tendered by the Commission in previous year(s).

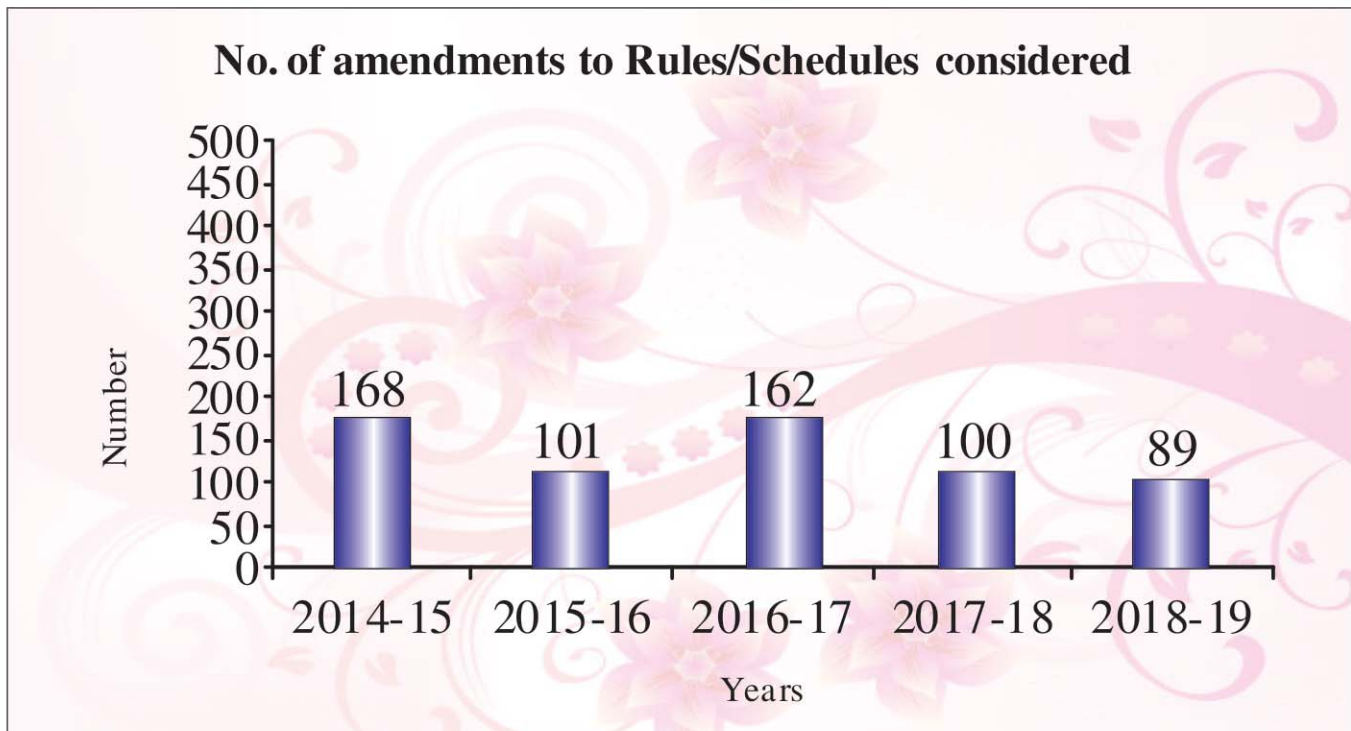

- 12.7 **Appeal/Review D.E. Cases** :- During the year under report, 01 case (F.No. F1(17)DE/2018-19) of Review Departmental Enquiry appeal was received.
- 12.8 **Litigations/Writs** :- During the year under report, 1398 cases in addition to 3397 cases of previous years of Civil suits/Complaints/ Writ petitions/appeals/D.B. special appeals/S.L.P. filed in the Civil Courts/High Court/Service Tribunal/Supreme Court/State Consumer Protection Commission/ District Consumer Forum etc. were pending, thus, making a total of 4795 cases. During the period under review, the number of cases decided by the various courts was 968. Thus, in all, 3827 cases were awaiting decision in the various Courts.

- 13.3 During the year under report the Government has promulgated New Service Rules and amendments in **26** Service Rules/Regulations as shown in Appendix-XV.
- 13.4 During the year under Report, the Commission dealt with One case of Recognition of Degree / Diploma / Certificate etc. Detail thereof has been given in Appendix-XVI.
- 13.5 During the year under Report the Commission received 5 cases of Compassionate Appointment of Dependents of Deceased Permanently incapacitated Armed Forces Service Personnel/Para Military Personnel on the post of TRA/Jr. Accountant for their concurrence. These cases were examined under the provisions of the Rajasthan Accounts Subordinate Service Rules, 1963 and the Rajasthan Revenue Accounts Subordinate Service Rules, 1975. APPENDICES

APPENDIX-I

Functions of the Commission

The functions exercised by the Rajasthan Public Service Commission are laid down in Article 320 of the Constitution of India.

The Public Service Commission shall be consulted:-

- (a) On all matters relating to methods of recruitment to civil services and for civil posts;
- (b) On the principles to be followed in making appointments to civil service and posts and in making promotions and transfers from one service to another and on the suitability of candidates for such appointments, promotions or transfers;
- (c) On all disciplinary matters affecting a person serving under State Government in civil capacity, including memorials or petitions relating to such matters;
- (d) On any claim by or in respect of a person who is serving or has served under the State Government, in a civil capacity that any costs incurred by him in defending legal proceeding instituted against him in respect of acts done or purporting to be done in the execution of his duty should be paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State;
- (e) On any claim for the award of a pension in respect of injuries sustained by a person while serving under the State Government in a civil capacity and any question as to the amount of any such award; and
- (f) Any other matter referred to them by the Government.

It shall not be necessary for the Commission to be consulted in matters relating to methods of recruitment to Civil Services and Posts, or the principles to be followed in making appointments to such posts, or the suitability of the candidates for such appointments :-

Unless otherwise provided in the relevant Service Rules for recruitment to any post in a Service, when the appointment is to be made to any post -

- 1 in Ministerial Service, or
- 2 in Subordinate Service or State Service whether technical or non-technical starting with an initial Grade Pay of "Rs. 3600/- or less per month" as per R.P.S.C. (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1951.

The hydrogeotourism approach will make the society more conscious towards these water bodies.
